The 2012 Citi Open is an ATP World Tour 500 tournament, making it one of the top 20 men's tournaments in the world. We have the same 6 box premium box seats to all sessions as in previous years (Aisle 36, Section 3). The seats are at the end of

the court and very close to the court. These seats provide access to the Courtside Club restaurant. We have two parking passes available for each session at \$15/pass. We also have 4 upper level seats (Section 7, Row J) at the same end of the court as our boxes to each session. The Sunday of the first weekend usually includes main draw matches as well as qualifying matches. Tickets also include the women's WTA International Level Event to be held at the same facility during this week (last year it was held in College Park).
